- be responsible for informing the school immediately of any changes to emergency contact details;

- show respect and care for other people in the school community, including other pupils and members of the teaching and non-teaching staff;
- show care and respect for school property and pay for the repair or replacement of anything they have lost or broken. This includes musical instruments;
- arrive at lessons on time and ready to give of their best, including completing homework set;
- wear the school's uniform correctly and with pride;
- do their best to be at school every day and on time, with all their equipment and books.
